Qualifications of Supervisor

The applicant assures that speech-language pathology assistants and/or aides will be supervised by the speech-language pathologist with a master's degree in speech-language pathology and a valid public school certificate/license issued by the Arkansas Department of Education (ADE) or a valid license issued by the Arkansas Board of Examiners in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology (ABESPA).

Code of Ethics

The applicant assures that individuals involved in the use of speech-language assistants and/or aides will abide by the Code of Ethics established by the American speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA).

Program Proposal

The applicant assures that the program will be implemented as outlined in the program proposal for the use of speech-language assistants and/or aides as approved by the ADE following the established guidelines.

Required Training

The applicant assures that the supervising speech-language pathologist(s) and the speech-language assistant(s) and/or aides(s) will participate in training as required by the Arkansas Department of Education guidelines.

Records and Reports

The applicant agrees to compile data, submit reports and keep such records as the ADE may require to ensure compliance with the guidelines.
